### YORKE PENINSUL COUNCIL – NEW BIN ROLL-OUT

See attached Council Communication advising of the replacement procedure of the red & yellow waste & recycle bins by SUEZ starting from Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> of January 2020.

The BPPA have contacted the Council with several concerns about the process which include;

- The short notice.
- The possibility that Black Point properties may not have rate payers in residence to place bins roadside.
- That bins may be collected for recycling with 2020 BPPA Membership stickers attached.
- That bins collected may be collected with bin locks or latches attached.

In response, SUEZ, (the waste bin contractors) in consultation with the contractors who will collect the old bins, have offered to collect Black Point bins last.

### IMPORTANT:

Therefore, Black Point bins will need to be left roadside from Monday the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 2020 to allow for the pickup of the old waste & recycle bins over the following 2 weeks without BPPA 2020 bin stickers & any lock or latches & no rubbish within.

PLEASE ENSURE NO RUBBISH IS PLACED IN YOUR OLD BINS AFTER YOU RECEIVE YOUR NEW BINS OR THE BINS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED BY THE CONTRACTORS.

We thank Council, SUEZ & the contractors for considering our concerns.

### DEPOSIT CONTAINER COLLECTION.

The festive season produces a lot of drink bottles & cans which can be recycled with the funds going to your community. Please use the blue bins stationed along Black Point Drive or contact Andrew Clarkson to arrange direct pick-ups by Bob Walkley.



**As part of the new Yorke Peninsula Council kerbside waste management contract**, brand new red and yellow lidded wheelie bins are being delivered to all eligible council properties, **commencing Monday January 13, 2020.**

Please bring your new bin into your property as soon as you can following delivery. **There will be no interruption or changes to your service.**

Old bins **MUST** be surrendered and will be collected and taken away to be **RECYCLED.**

Following delivery of your new bins, your old bins will be serviced **one final time.** After which, please ensure they remain **EMPTY** and are left out in front of your property until they are collected and taken away.

Please leave them up against the boundary or fence-line or in the case of some rural properties, at the location that they normally get serviced.

**PLEASE** leave old bins out until they are collected.
